Competition Rules

The CMAS Target Shooting rules govern the competition for 3 and 4 meter shots. It is supplemented by this document specific to the "World Cup" classification.

SPECIFIC RULES OF THE COMPETITION

For this edition of the World Cup, Participation is open to National Federations and clubs This competition will include

- A ranking of the event by sex (except relay which is mixed), by event, by format (3m, 4m)
- A General classification for clubs (see definition below)
- A General classification by country (see definition below)

Each team is made up of 2 or 3 athletes, and they must be defined when registering in the CMAS portal

Teams can be mixed.

The CMAS license is NOT mandatory to participate in the World Cup. Only the CMAS entry fee is applied (24€ per participant)



COMPETITION

The competition's events:

- Precision
- Biathlon
- Super biathlon
- Relay

A team can participate in both formats.

A team must complete all the events in one format to have a club or a country ranking.

A format (3 or 4 m) will have events organised if 3 Teams participate in this format at least.



COMPETITION AREA

- An Olympic swimming pool for the competition
- 8 Ianes
- 50m
- Depth of 2 to 3 m
- The swimming pool is available from 16/10 in the afternoon to 18/10 after the end of the competition
- A visit for a presentation is scheduled for the afternoon of October 16th
- For the training, the time slots must be booked in advance to check availability and organisational possibilities



HOW TO GET AROUND DURING THE 3 DAYS

- Between the competition venue "Olympic swimming pool of Radès", accommodation and ceremony sites
- A bus is available during the times mentioned,
- You can contact the organisation's managers for other optional trips
 - Between the airport and the hotel
 - Distance 19 km, journey time approx. 15 min
 - Either By taxi

ACCOMMODATION



- Accommodation is the Hotel Ezzahra Dar Tunis
- 6.3 km from the Olympic swimming pool in Radès
- 8.9 km from Tunis Carthage Airport
- 18.5 km from Tunis city center "22 min"









REGISTRATION ACCOMMODATION

- The terms and conditions of all expenses related to the competition (accommodation costs, registration fees, transport to the swimming pool) are paid directly to the Organising Committee according to the instructions given below:
- The organisers are offering two registration options before the event registration deadline (July 15, 2024).

Option 1

- Full board accommodation 3 nights (double room for 2 people), from 16 to 19 October Includes all meals, 3 breakfasts, 2 snacks at the pool, welcome dinner and closing toast, hotel/pool transfer.
- €320/person for competitors and €260/person for accompanying persons and managers,

Option 2

o If you choose the hotel, meals and transport yourself, participation in the event will cost you 160€.

REGISTRATION FOR THE COMPETITION

All team and athlete event registrations must be submitted electronically only in the CMAS portal.

The National Federations should use his account in the CMAS Portal

Each club must create an account for each athlete on the CMAS portal:

https://portal.cmas.org

Pay the CMAS FEES per participant (24€)

Register each <u>Team</u> and <u>Athlete</u> in the CMAS portal.

Register every judge, coach and team official also in the CMAS portal.

MODIFICATIONS TO THE CMAS REGULATION

- Reminder: In the Super-Biathlon event, a valid visual is one with an impact worth 100 points, as defined in point 2.6.1 of the CMAS rules.
 An athlete's race (course) is valid as long as he or she meets the conditions of point 7.3.1.
 The notion of a valid visual does not intervene in the definition of a valid race.
- In the relay event, the starting line is reduced to 7m from the shooting line (C) for the 3m format.
- The race of a relay team (relay event) is only valid if 9 complete runs and 9 shots have been done.

MODIFICATIONS TO THE CMAS REGULATION

- Teams of 2 athletes will be weighted at 3/2 on their individual event scores when calculating the combined scores in the club and countries rankings.
- Teams of 2 athletes will do the relay event by making 5 shots for one and 4 for the other with a relay pass between each shot.

Classification of the events (according to point 9 of the rules)

Athletes or teams are ranked in each event following the general CMAS rules. Each of these rankings has a podium and an awards ceremony.

Combined Scores

For the calculation of the combined scores, the performances in the Super-Biathlon event are converted into points according to the following formula:

For men: 5000 - (time x 6) - (5 - (VV + if(time>240; 1; 0) + if(time>285; 1; 0))) x (45x6)

For women: 5000 - (time x 6) - (5 - (VV + if(time>270; 1; 0) + if(time>315; 1; 0))) x (45x6)

or

- 5000 is the maximum points quota on the event,
- time is the time achieved by the athlete in the event, expressed in seconds
- VV is the number of "Valid Visuals" on the target
- 6 is the value of the second in points
- 45x6 is the value in points of the penalty for exceeding the time limit mentioned in point 7.3.1 of the CMAS regulation

General Club Classification

The <u>combined score</u> of a team is the sum of the scores obtained by the team or its members in the different events (relay + scores of each member).

The General Club classification is a combined classification: It is established by ranking the best teams of each club among themselves according to their <u>combined team score</u> from the highest for first place, to the lowest for last place

General countries Ranking

<u>A team's event score in an individual event is the sum of the points acquired by its members in this event.</u>

The <u>country score</u> in an event is the <u>event score</u> of the strongest team of that country in that event.

A <u>country's combined</u> score is the sum of the <u>country scores</u> obtained by that country in each event.

The General Country ranking is a combined ranking: It is established by ranking countries according to their combined country scores, from the highest for first place to the lowest for last.

General ranking for Clubs or Countries

The combined classification is done without distinction of format (3 or 4m).

In the event of a tie in the combined rankings, the ties are separated by their highest score

- in the relay event

- then in the biathlon event
- then in the super-biathlon event
- then in the accuracy event
