Athens Airport: El Venizelos



As a matter of fact, in 2023, Athens Airport welcomed more than 28.17 million tourists, springing back and even exceeding its pro-covid levels.


The airport of the Greek capital offers its passengers a wide range of amenities as well as quick and effective services.

GENERAL INFORMATION



- Only participants with a CMAS license are eligible to compete in the Championship.
- The registration of participants means that they accept and respect the championship rules, the safety conditions set by the organizers and the CMAS rules and regulations.
- Each country may enter a maximum of 4 athletes per age category/ discipline/men/women.
- Medalist athletes from last year WC, are not included in the quota of 4 athletes.
- Masters have no limitations in athletes per country.
- Entries must be submitted to CMAS portal within deadlines <u>https://portal.cmas.org/login</u>.
- Registration has to be done through National federation's account.
- If the National federation has not yet an account pls contact CMAS admin at joaojose@cmas.org
- World Seniors Championship will occur over five competition days.
- World Juniors Championship will occur over the same competition days and same registration procedure through cmas portal.
- World Masters Championship will occur over the same competition days but Masters will apply for individual registration at cmas portal.
- Age Categories are as defined at the relevant CMAS freediving rules.

• According the rules: The sequence of the starts is based on the Personal Best of the athletes as noted at the registration of the athlete for an event. Personal Best is the best result in an official competition

in the current or the previous year. In Static athletes can announce a time lower than their Personal Best. The athletes with the shortest time or the shorter distance will compete first while the athletes with the longer time or longer distance will compete last.

• National federations must register the actual official performances of all selected athletes to cmas portal. If there is not existing an official performance it will count as zero (0) and the athlete will start first.

DOPING CONTROL

Anti-doping tests will be conducted during the championship according to the international rules of WADA and the CMAS anti-doping code.

The organizing committee guarantees to provide doping control according to the CMAS and WADA rules.

MEDICAL SERVICES

Medical doctors will be present during the competition and will provide first aid. For more serious health issues, an ambulance will be outside the venue to transfer to the nearest state hotel. Health issues and need for hospital care from places other than the swimming pool has to be taken care by the teams or by each person.

Medical and hospital expenses are upon teams-athletes.

INSURANCE

All teams must ensure that all their participants have adequate private health and repatriation insurance during 2025 CMAS WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP FREEDIVING INDOOR Athens Greece. The participants should purchase adequate medical insurance and repatriation insurance at their place of departure. The medical insurance shall at least cover accidental medical treatment, sudden illness and hospitalization allowance.

The repatriation insurance shall cover the costs in case of an emergency where you need to return to your place of departure. All participants must have valid insurance and provide the insurance certificate upon request. CMAS, Greek federation and Organizing committee will not be liable for any risks arising therefrom.

PARTICIPATION FEES

Athletes' competition fees are **550€** per person as Organizing Fees.

Officials, coaches, assistants, visitors, reporters, viewers etc. have to be registered and accredited to enter the pool.

Registration-accreditation fees other than athletes: 250 euro

DEADLINES FOR ENTRY AND PARTICIPATION

• Initial entry form and entry fee full payment or at least 50% should be sent to the Organizing Committee, together with a copy of the bank transfer. Any time from 01/01/2025 but not later than 28/02/2025 • Registration at portal and payment of CMAS fees and licenses No later than 15/04/2025

• Full competitor list and full payment No later than 20/04/2025

PAYMENTS

Full amount should be transferred to LOC **no later than 20/04/2025.** After this date, the participation fees will increase by a further 10% of the total amount. The remaining payment should be paid upon arrival.

Receipts of the payments will be available at the competition time. We need **full data** (name of organization, full address, Tel) and copy of the transfer, to create the receipts and/or invoices. If it is need for a receipt earlier or upon transfer, you have to send a requesting email with full data of the organization-athlete and a copy of the transfer.

If you require a letter for visa, please contact the organizing committee at least two months before entry.

REFUND POLICY

1) Requesting Removal from the competition

• 1a. Teams or athletes requesting to be removed from the competition need to do so via email to LOC, by the captain or the coach of the team. We will use the date and time stamp as verification to when the request was sent. Phone calls, messages and texts will not be accepted.

• 1b. Any team or athlete that requests to be removed from the competition, before 30 days of the start date of the competition, will be removed with no administration fees accessed and full refund.

• 1c. Any team that requests removal from the competition 30 days or less from the start date, will have a euro 100 per person, administration fee, deducted from their entry fee. The refund will be 50% at the remaining amount.

• 1d. No refund will be issued for hotel or transfer expenses if less than 30 days.

2) No refund will be issued to any team or athlete that requests removal from the competition 10 days or less from the start date of the competition.

3) None paid teams or athletes, will not be allowed to participate until the fee is paid.

HOTELS

Teams, officials, athletes and Participants will be accommodated in several proposed hotels.

Because of the different prices of the hotels, food etc the hotels and the booking will be selected and decided from the National teams. To help the selection process organizing committee has a few hotels proposal based on a selection preference.

The selection of each hotel and the payment of the hotels will be directly from each National team to hotels or booking platforms.

If there is need for help for booking from organization side, pls contact organizing committee.

Daily transfers to and from the OAKA swimming pool will be arranged from proposed hotels only, via dedicated buses, provided by the organizing committee, ensuring smooth and timely movement for the participants. Teams and/or athletes that will stay in other hotels or apartments have to arrange their transfers by their own.

Pls take care for early booking (till February) because May is full season for Athens hotels and the availability will be limited.

Transfers from airport to hotels are possible with a cost of 70 euros per person both ways. Inform the Organizing Committee of your arrival details at least 30 days or earlier if you will need a transfer to your hotel.
