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Conditions of participation

Every CMAS country is entitled to participate if they accept the rules in effect and the relevant CMAS regulation.

Each national federation can be represented by a team consisting of the following members:

- Adult team:**
- 1 team manager
 - 5 women
 - 5 men
 - 1 trainer

- Junior team**
(15-21 years old)
- 1 team manager
 - 5 junior (female)
 - 5 junior (male)
 - 1 trainer

Additionally, federation can represented in team events in following way:

- One woman team and one men team in the TEAM-event (type A).
- Maximum 2 mixed teams (2 women and 2 men) in the TEAM-event (type C).
- Unlimited adult women teams and unlimited adult men teams in the MONK event.
- Unlimited junior mixed teams (1 woman and 1 man) in the MONK event.

Three men and three women respectively can compete for each nation in the individual events. Three female juniors and three male juniors respectively can compete for each nation in the individual events in youth category.

- **Registration** for the 2025 European Championships will take place on the CMAS portal <https://portal.cmas.org/login>. The portal for registering for the European Championship is available on the CMAS homepage.
- In CMAS Portal it is required to pay **CMAS fee for participation** (25€), before it is available to add the participants to competition.
This cost is not included in the participation fee. These costs must be paid to the CMAS directly through CMAS Portal.

- **Confirmation of payment** should be sent **before 07.07.2025** to sport@skfortuna.ee.

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Additional information

1. All events will be held according to the current rules of the CMAS.
2. Every athlete must have a valid CMAS license and a medical certificate not older than one year.
3. The organizer offers compressor service. (DIN- and INT adapters are available). Only cylinders with a valid DIN/EN certificate will be filled.
4. The competitors themselves are responsible for the proper condition of their equipment.
5. Every athlete must have their own buoy. The buoy has to be marked with the flag, the name of the nation and the name of the competitor.
6. Every team must bring 2 national flag.
7. **All athletes must have ADEL certification:** proof of completion of the Adel (Anti-Doping eLearning) Certification issued by WADA. This is required to register for all CMAS competitions in CMAS Portal.

Liability: The organizer declines any liability. All competitors take part at their own risk. The organizer keeps the right for modification.
