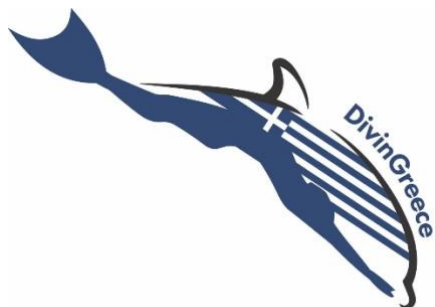


2026 CMAS World Cup Freediving Depth, Mytikas

1.Event schedule

-5/9/2026 official registration (documents – lanyards – etc)

-6/9 – 12/9 competition days. (5 days of competition and 2 days off)

- 6&7/9 competition days
- 8/9 day off
- 9&10/9 competition days
- 11/9 day off
- 12/9 competition day

-12/9/2026 medals & closing ceremony

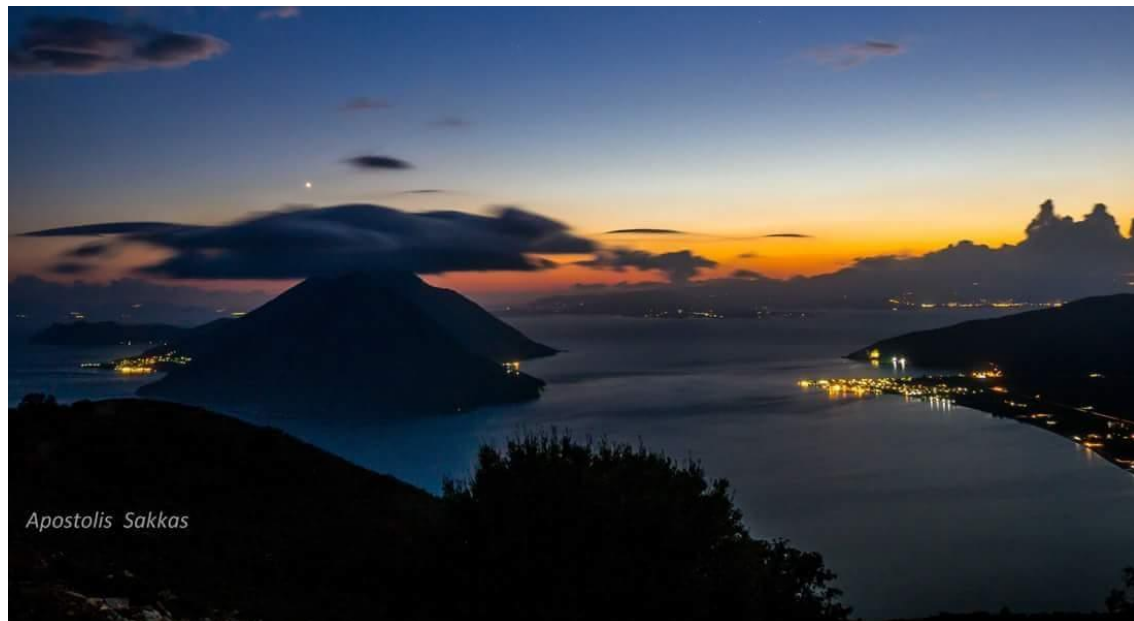
In case of cancellation on any day because of weather conditions, this day may be reserved for competition activities upon decision of the Technical Delegate.

2.Competition's program

There will be CWT, FIM, CNF and CWTBF for Seniors Men and Women.

Competition starts Sunday September 6 and ends Saturday September 12. There will be five competition days and two days off (check schedule above)

Each athlete can choose same or different discipline for any day. Best discipline's performance counts for final classification of each discipline.



3. Training

The week before athletes can train using the official set-up (counter ballast, scooter safety, sonar, safety divers etc...)

Training starts Monday August 31 and ends Saturday September 5.

4.Other Special Events

Local gastronomy events and daily cruises are going to be organized during the two weeks (training & competition week)

5.Notes

-As some of the actions will take place according the competition finishing time, final program will be announced at technical meeting before the competition.

-The event is open to the athletes aged 18 and over fully complying with the provisions of CMAS Regulations.

-CMAS, the Competition Director, Competition Officers and the Technical Delegates are not responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during or after the competition. The organizer ensures the presence of medical assistance.

-The rules of competitions applied will be: CMAS Freediving International Rules Depth Competitions (find them on www.cmas.org)

-All participating athletes shall accept and follow the international rules of WADA.

- All athletes must be in possession of:

- Valid CMAS freediving sports license
- Medical certificate not older than 12 months
- ID document-Passport.
- Medical Insurance (for example DAN Europe Silver Sport)*
- ADEL certificate

Also, athletes have to fulfill all the liability release documents concerning the competition.

Athletes that fail to provide the above documents will not be allowed to take part in the competitions, and their participation fee will not be refunded.

*** INSURANCE**

- All athletes must have adequate private health and repatriation insurance during competition.
- The participants should purchase adequate medical insurance and repatriation insurance at their place of departure.
- The medical insurance shall cover accidental medical treatment, sudden illness and hospitalization allowance, including hyperbaric chamber treatment.
- Medical insurance must be valid in Greece.
- The repatriation insurance shall cover the costs in case of an emergency where you need to return to your place of departure. CMAS and Organizing committee will not be liable for any risks arising there from
- Responsibility for Off-Venue Incidents: Any health issues or injuries occurring outside the designated competition area are the responsibility of the individual athletes or their teams, including transportation and medical care arrangements.
- Medical Expenses: Athletes or their federations are responsible for medical expenses including hospital, transportation, and hyperbaric chamber expenses.

- Diving-Related Accidents: In the event of any accident occurring during a dive, the athlete must undergo a medical evaluation at the local hospital. Further participation or travel will only be permitted upon clearance by the attending medical professionals in accordance with the established medical protocol.

6.Registration

General Information

- All participants should respect the Competition rules, the safety conditions set by the Organizers and CMAS rules and regulations.
- The event is open to the athletes aged 18 and over fully complying with the provisions of CMAS Regulations.
- CMAS, the Competition Director, International Technical Officials and the Technical Delegate are not responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during or after the competition. The Local Organizing Committee ensures the presence of medical assistance.
- This event is open for individual registration.

How to do your registration

- Log into CMAS portal <https://portal.cmas.org/>
- Go to the event section <https://portal.cmas.org/cmas/evt-events/events>
- Use the filter options to find the event you want to register.
- Enter the event page. Scroll down. Start registration procedure.
- Assign disciplines you plan to compete.
- Add official Personal Best result in each discipline (PB must not be older than 1 year before competition start). If there is no existing an official personal best unofficial personal best must be provided for safety reasons.
- Pay CMAS competition fee (invoice will be created automatically).

7.Fees
