# How to get to the Island

#### From America:

- Direct flight Miami-Dominica.
- Direct flight San Juan-Dominica.
- Flight to a neighboring island (Barbados, Guadeloupe etc.) + flight/ferry to Dominica.

#### From Europe:

- Flight Paris-Guadeloupe/Martinique + ferry Guadeloupe/Martinique-Dominica.
- Flight to Miami + direct flight to Dominica.

### NOTES:

When looking for flights, don't get confused with the Dominican Republic (DO). The correct airport is Melville Hall (DOM), also known as Charles Douglas.

The airport is in Marigot, in the north of the island. To get to Soufriere, you will take a taxi. It is a 1.30-hour ride and it costs 100usd.

The ferry is in Roseau. To get to Soufriere, you will take a taxi. It is a 30 minute ride and it costs 40usd.
