The Competition will be organized on the small island of Gozo in the Mediterranean. Gozo is part of Malta and the sea around Gozo is known for its clear water and depth close to the coast. The competition is organized by the Danish Sports Diving Association and we cooperate with local players on Gozo and Malta. Gozo is the northernmost island of the Maltese Islands - is approx. 14 km long and 7 km wide. This makes it very easy to get around to the many fine dive spots - and since there is deep water close to the coast on both the NORTH SOUTH and WEST coasts - we can always find a good dive site.

Temperature: 32 degrees celcius

Water Tempo : 28 degrees celcius

Wind: Low porbal' bility of wind thatwill affect competition

Thermocline: Deep and minimal – we will update when we are closer.

NOTES

- Danish Sportdiving Federation, the Competition Director and Competition Officers are not responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during or after the competition.
- The organizer ensures the presence of medical assistance.
The rules of competitions applied will be: CMAS Freediving International Rules Depth Competition
- Athletes must be in possession of:
 - Valid CMAS freediving sports license
 - Insurance
 - Medical certificate not older than 12 months
 - ID document- Passport.

Athletes that fail to provide the above documents will not be allowed to take part in the competitions, and their participation fee will not be refunded. Also, athletes have to fulfill all the liability release documents concerning the competition. Medical document: You shall provide a signed medical that declares you fit to participate in freediving competition.

Medical Services/Responsibility and Insurance.

Medical Support & Emergency Procedures On-Site Medical Coverage: Qualified medical doctor will be present throughout the competition to provide immediate first aid and initial medical support.

Emergency Transport: In the event of more serious medical situations, an emergency boat will be transferring you with competition doctor to shore and facilitate rapid transfer to the nearest hospital. Responsibility for Off-Venue Incidents: Any health issues or injuries occurring outside the designated competition area are the responsibility of the individual athletes or their teams, including transportation and medical care arrangements. Medical Expenses: All medical and

hospital expenses are the responsibility of the athletes or their teams. The organizing committee does not cover these costs. Diving-Related Accidents: In the event of any accident occurring during a dive, the athlete must undergo a medical evaluation by the event doctor. Further participation or travel will only be permitted upon clearance by the attending medical professionals in accordance with the established medical protocol.

INSURANCE All participants must have adequate private health and repatriation insurance during Gozo Apnea Games 2025. The participants should purchase adequate medical insurance and repatriation insurance at their place of departure. The medical insurance shall at least cover accidental medical treatment, sudden illness and hospitalization allowance. The repatriation insurance shall cover the costs in case of an emergency where you need to return to your place of departure. All participants must have valid insurance and provide the insurance certificate upon request. Danish Sportdiving Federation and the Organizing committee will not be liable for any risks arising therefrom.

REFUND POLICY

Requesting Removal from the competition

- 1a. Athletes requesting to be removed from the competition need to do so via email fridykning.udvalg@sportsdykning.dk. We will use the date and time stamp as verification to when the request was sent. Phone calls, messages and texts will not be accepted.
- 1b. Any athlete that requests to be removed from the competition, before 30 days of the start date of the competition, will be removed with no administration fees assessed and full refund.
- 1c. Any athlete that requests removal from the competition 30 days or less from the start date, will receive no refund.
