




2026 CMAS OPEN INTERNATIONAL FREEDIVING INDOOR SANTA MARTA 500+



SANTA MARTA - COLOMBIA



Santa Marta is a coastal city on the Caribbean Sea in the northern Colombian Department of Magdalena. A vibrant port city and the first Spanish settlement in Colombia, it serves as the gateway to Tayrona National Natural Park and to the Sierra Nevada de Santa Marta, including guided multi-day treks to the Lost City (Teyuna) archaeological site.





OFFICIAL INVITATION

The Federacion Colombiana de Actividades Subacuaticas(FEDECAS) with the agreement of CMAS, invite all interested Federations, Clubs and Athletes to participate in the **2026 CMAS Open International Freediving Indoor Santa Marta 500+** to be held from October 22nd to 25th 2026 in Santa Marta, Colombia.

1. COMPETITION DETAILS

The Draft Program of the event is as follows:

- October 22ND registrations- Technical meeting 18:15h.
- October 23rd – 24th – 25th competition days
- Participation: Athletes can register individually for each discipline until Oct 21st, 2026.
- Disciplines : DYN, DNF, DYNBF, STA
- Categories: Junior, Senior, Master I, II, III.
- Gender: Women, Men.

All participating athletes shall accept and follow the international rules of WADA and CMAS International.

In accordance with the rules of CMAS, starting lists in the competition will be in order of personal best.

Medals and official rankings will be awarded for each discipline, category, and gender.

2. REGISTRATION

The opening date of registration is from **Wednesday April 1st, 2026.**

All athletes must register until **Wednesday October 21st, 2026.** to participate in the competition, athletes must:

- Familiarize yourself with the Rules and Regulations of the CMAS Pool competition.
- Register as a competitor through the [CMAS Portal](#).
- Pay the CMAS Fees of €25,5 for the CMAS licenses, pay via CMAS Portal directly to the CMAS in the registration process.
- Every athlete can choose the discipline that wants to compete. All events will be declared in the CMAS portal with your best PB to organize the official start lists.

3. PARTICIPATION FEE

The participation fees are:

- USD 250 (payment received before September 1st, 2026)
- USD 300 (payment received after September 1st, 2026)

Payment must be completed no later than October 22nd at the account (contact organizer).

5. SPECIAL NOTES

CMAS, FEDECAS, Organizers, Competition Director, Competition Officers, judges, staff, volunteers and the Technical Delegate are not responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during or after the competition. The organizer ensures the presence of medical assistance.

-The rules of competitions applied will be: CMAS Pool Rules

-All participating athletes shall accept and follow the international rules of WADA and to have the ADEL certificate uploaded in the CMAS Portal.

- All athletes must be in possession of:

- Medical certificate not older than 6 months
- ID document-Passport.
- Insurance coverage.
- Liability release document

Athletes who fail to provide the above documents will not be permitted to compete, the competitions, and their participation fee will not be refunded.

For training days before the start the competition, the athletes must send an email to jdfedecas@gmail.com no later than **September 22, 2026** to check availability, schedule time and cost.

6. WORLD OR CONTINENTAL RECORD ATTEMPT

Athletes intending to attempt a World or Continental Record must contact the organizer in advance to declare the discipline, category and obtain information regarding of cost of each Anti-Doping Test control.
