Barranquilla is the capital district of the <u>Atlántico department</u> in <u>Colombia</u>. It is located near the <u>Caribbean Sea</u> and is the largest city and third port in the <u>Caribbean coast region</u>; as of 2022, it had a population of 1,906,319 making it <u>Colombia's fourth-most populous city</u> after <u>Bogotá</u>, <u>Medellín</u>, and <u>Cali</u>.

Barranquilla lies strategically next to the delta of the <u>Magdalena River</u>, 7.5 km (4.7 mi) (originally 25 km (16 mi) before rapid urban growth) from its mouth at the Caribbean Sea, serving as a port for river and maritime transportation within Colombia. It is also the main economic center of the <u>Atlántico</u> department in Colombia. The city is the core of the <u>Barranquilla metropolitan area</u>, with a population of over 3 million, which also includes the municipalities of <u>Soledad</u>, <u>Galapa</u>, <u>Malambo</u>, and <u>Puerto Colombia</u>.

Barranquilla was legally established as a town on April 7, 1813, although it dates from at least 1629. It grew into an important port, serving as a haven for immigrants from Europe, especially during and immediately following World War I and World War II, when waves of additional immigrants from the Middle East and Asia arrived. Barranquilla became Colombia's main port, and with its level of industrialization and modernity, it earned the nickname "Colombia's Golden Gate" (Spanish: *La Puerta de Oro de Colombia*). In the 1940s, Barranquilla was the second-largest city in Colombia and one of the most modern cities in the Caribbean and in South America; later local administrations, due to widespread corruption in their ranks, brought about a decline in the standard of living. As government investment increased in other Colombian cities, Barranquilla's national position was eclipsed.

Barranquilla has hosted the <u>2018 Central American and Caribbean Games</u>. The city is home to one of the most important folk and cultural festivals of Colombia, the <u>Carnival of Barranquilla</u>, which was declared a National Cultural Heritage by the <u>Congress of Colombia</u> in 2001 and recognized by <u>UNESCO</u> in 2003

The Federacion Colombiana de Actividades Subacuaticas – FEDECAS with the agreement of CMAS, invite all interested Federations and Clubs to participate in the CMAS Freediving World Cup Pool Series 2024 organized October 3RD 5TH 2024 in Barranquilla – Colombia.

1. EVENT SCHEDULE

The Draft Program of the event is as follows:

- October 2nd registrations- Technical meeting 18:15h hotel Cra. 53 #N° 54 41, Nte. Centro Historico, Barranquilla, Atlántico.
- October 3rd 4th 5th competition days
- The closing ceremony will take place on 5th October.
- Participation: Athletes can register individually for each event.
- Disciplines: will include the following disciplines:

Senior Male: DYN, DNF, DYNBF

Senior Female: DYN, DNF, DYNBF

2. COMPETITION DETAILS

Every athlete can choose the discipline that wants to compete.

Athletes can compete in the same discipline as many competition days they want. Mixed discipline starts are allowed. Specific rules for the WORLD CUP POOL SERIES will be also applied.

The relevant rules for each discipline are applied.

The event is open to athletes aged 18 and over. Seniors' category only.

The rules of competitions applied will be the relevant CMAS Pool Rules.

3. REGISTRATION

4. SCORING AND CLASSIFICATION of Apnea Games and POOL SERIES

Event medals

3 first places for men and women in each discipline in each event

• Scoring and Classification System for the overall event

winner: DYN:1 point per meter

DYNBF:1 point per meter

DNF: 1.25 points per meter

Overall winner:

There will be a ranking for the event as follows:

The athlete with the best sum, adding points from his best performances, from all 3 disciplines or less (if he has not participated at all disciplines).

Even If an athlete has not participated at all disciplines, his total score counts at the event

ranking. e.g

DYN:100 mt=100 points

DYNBF:95 mt =95 points

DNF: 80mtx1,25= 100

points Total 295 points

Total Classification of the CMAS FREEDIVING WORLD CUP POOL

SERIES: Calculating Total Points:

For each participant, adding the total points earned in their two best events.

Overall, Winner:

The athlete with the highest total points on his best two events is declared the overall winner.













5. PARTIACION FEE

The participation fees are:

- 100 USD per 1 competition day.
- 200 USD per 2 competitions days.
- 250 USD per 3 competitions days.

The Apnea world cup in Barranquilla as part of the CMAS FREEDIVING WORLD CUP POOL SERIES provide World Record status and qualification criteria for World Games 2025.

CMAS, Federation, Organizers, Competition Director, Competition Officers and the Technical Delegates are not responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during or after the competition. The organizer ensures the presence of medical assistance.

- -All participating athletes shall accept and follow the international rules of WADA.
- All athletes must be in possession of:
 - Temporary CMAS freediving online license
 - Medical certificate not older than 6 months
 - ID document-Passport.
 - Insurance
 - Liability release document

Athletes that fail to provide the above documents will not be allowed to take part in the competitions, and their participation fee will not be refunded.

9. HOTEL PROPOSAL AND TRANSPORTATION

The organization recommend that each Team to reserve with the organizing committee the transportation of the arrival and departure from the International Airport, is the best option but, other option is the use of the official taxis from the airport or UBER or any similar App.

The Barranquilla International Airport is 25kms from the hotel and swimming pool. The price per person for transportation with the organization, from the airport to the hotel and return is 50 euro or 55 us dollars for 5 persons or less and 30 euro or 35 us dollars for groups

of 6 persons and more.

For any participating wish to arrive earlier to have training session a full board services are offered, paying the pro-rata charge as indicated above. Swimming pool lanes are charged separately (20euro or 25 us dollars per line per hour).



Triple Room: 260 us dollars/ 240 Euro per person (Full Board included).




10. LOCATION
