A vibrant cultural and events scene



4. Presentation of the Competition Venue

The competition will take place at “Jean Régis” swimming pool, 90 chemin des Fins, 74000 Annecy

Swimming pool Size:

- Length [25m]
- Width [15m]
- Number of lanes: [6]
- Depth [1,80m]
- The temperature of the water is [28 °C]
- Number of spectators: [50]

Warm-ups and Equipment Testing: Leisure Pool

Rooms

- A meeting room/office for officials
- A meeting room for referees
- A room/office for scoring (scoring points and entering results into the computer system)
- A lockable room for equipment (e.g., storage space under the stands)
- A space for giant screens and computers (balcony area above the 25m pool)
- A lunch break area
- Men's/Women's changing rooms
- Boys'/Girls' changing rooms
- A first aid room equipped with oxygen therapy equipment

Required Equipment

- An internet connection for entering results and streaming events
- A giant screen for displaying sponsors and partners and presenting the FFESSM (French Federation of Underwater Studies and Sports)
- Cameras for broadcasting events on a giant screen.

The leisure pool can be used to organize introductory freediving sessions and target shooting, offered to the general public.

Reserved for competitors and organizers, located near the aquatic center




5. General information

For each round, in order to participate, each competitor is required to pay through the CMAS Portal the CMAS fees fixed annually by CMAS.

- 25,53 € for participation fees by each round for 2026.

Note that the names of relay members must be entered during the registration process on the base of individual registration even if they only swim relay and even according to the rules, the composition of relays can be changed on site before the beginning of competition.

The CMAS fees will be paid only at the end of the registration process online, by credit card.
