1. Competition

This will be the first edition of the CMAS Pool World Cup in Belgrade-Serbia.

2. Place and date of the competition

The CMAS Pool World Cup in Belgrade will be held on 05.04. and 06.04.2025.

The venue for the competition will be Sport Center New Belgrade (11. April) Swimming Pool,

Auto put za Novi Sad br. 2, Belgrade.


Olympic Pool - 50 meters with 8 lines; the depth along the entire length is 2,0 meters;

the water temperature of 26,0 $^{\circ}$ C.

Small Pool 25 meters x 4 lines; the depth along te entire length is 1,25 meters; the water temperature of $26,0 \circ C$.

4. Registration for the competition

TO TAKE PART IN THE COMPETITION MUST:

- Need to know the Rules and Regulations of the CMAS (Procedures and Obligations, Freediving pool rules and Freediving World Cup pool).
- Register as a competitor through the CMAS Portal
 - ✓ Log into CMAS portal <u>https://portal.cmas.org/cmas/dashboard</u>
 - ✓ Go to the event section <u>https://portal.cmas.org/cmas/evt-events/events</u>
 - \checkmark Use the filter options to find easier the event you want to register
- Register in the system and pay the CMAS Fees of €25 for the CMAS World Cup licenses, pay via CMAS Portal directly to the CMAS in the registration process.
- The registration is valid and confirmed only after payment online in the system.

THE ENTRY FEE TO PAY TO THE LOCAL ORGANISING COMMITTEE :

Payable by 15.03.2025.: €200 for 2 days or €150 for one day.

Payable after 15.03.2025.: \in 250 for 2 days and \notin 200 for one day.

Due to circumstances connected with the competition's organisation, the entry fee and competitor registration must be made by **24.03.2025**.

Following the rules of CMAS starts in the Competitions take place in the order of personal best.

TO BE ADMITTED TO THE COMPETITION YOU MUST:

- register for the competition in <u>CMAS Portal</u>
- be at least 18 years of age,
- present a medical certificate stating that there are no contraindications to diving no older than one year from the date of issue,
- present an identity card or passport on the day of the competition at registration,
- sign the waiver of liability declaration,
- pay the entry fee

5. Competition Regulations

Two competition days (05, and 06, of April 2025). Every athlete can choose the discipline that wants to compete in each day. Mixed discipline starts are allowed. The competition is played only in the senior category.

Scoring and Classification System for the overall winner:

There will be two types of classification:

- overall winner's classification
- events/disciplines medal classifications

Overall winners classification: DYN:1 point per meter DBF:1 point per meter DNF: 1.25 points per meter STA: 1 point per 4 seconds SPE 2x50: 31 sec. is 320 points, every sec. more than 31 is -4 points, and every sec. less than 31 +5 points

Results from all 5 disciplines (or if the athlete starts in fewer disciplines (events), the best performance from performed disciplines/events) will be added for the overall winner's classification.

Events/disciplines medal classifications

3 first places for men and women in the discipline (the best performances will be considered) will be awarded medals.

- The schedule can be changed depending on the number of participants
- The competition will be held in 4 lanes, the start for STA and SPE will be at the same time, and the start for DNF; DBF; and DYN will be for the A/C lane at the same time and for the B/D lane at the same time, the difference between start A/C and B/D is 4 minutes

6. Accommodation

In the part of Belgrade called New Belgrade, there are large offer of hotels, hostels, and B&Bs / AirBNBs which are close to the swimming pool.

We recommend hotel Villa Forest, Ruzino drvo nb 5, 11080 Zemun, it is 300m from the pool.

7. Anti-Doping Control

- WADA World Antidoping Code
- CMAS Antidoping Rules
- Athletes accept these rules as a condition of participation.

The International Testing Agency (ITA) decides the testing plan of the competition and sends it to LOC.

Additional CMAS individual tests are possible during competition.

All the controls and procedures are under the authority of CMAS - "testing authority "and result management".

Tests for benzodiazepines will be performed at competitions following the CMAS Rules.

8. Media, results

The competition will be broadcast online.

The media patronage over the competition is held by TV Arena

Online results service is provided by freedivingranking.com

9. Complaints

Managed by the CMAS Technical Delegate according to the CMAS rules. In 2025, the amount is 100 €.
