



nOxyCup 2025 - CMAS Hungarian Open Indoor Freediving Championship

Information for athletes

1. Aim of the competition

The aim of the competition is to promote competitive indoor apnea. The event will serve as an opportunity for national and international qualification and ranking of athletes.

2. Date and place of the competition

4. Jury

- According CMAS rules

5. Registration prerequisites

Athletes must comply to following criteria to be able to compete:

- has a valid (not older than 1 year) medical certificate
- signed medical statement
- signed liability release statement
- at least 18 years old
- fully completed registration by the registration deadline

6. Registration

Registration is possible via email to hello@noxygen.hu

CMAS registration: All entries can be made by the Nationals federations, clubs and/or Individuals. Registration for the competition <https://portal.cmas.org/>

TO TAKE PART IN THE COMPETITION MUST:

- Need to know the Rules and Regulations of CMAS (Procedures and Obligations, Freediving pool rules)
- Log into CMAS portal <https://portal.cmas.org/cmas/dashboard>
- Go to the event section <https://portal.cmas.org/cmas/evt-events/events>
- Use the filter options to find the event you want to register.

- Register at disciplines and pay online the 25 euro registration fees.
- Without registering in CMAS portal, the participation is not valid and no results will be published for any non-registered athlete.

Additional information:

- **Registration starts: 1 April, 2025**
- **Registration ends: 7 November, 2025**
- Limited spots available on a first come first serve basis (maximum of 70 spots)
- The registration is complete when the athlete receives written confirmation via email
- Incomplete registrations are invalid
- The organizer reserves the right to decline registration once the spots have been filled

7. Entry fee

The entry fee is:

- **79,- EUR - 1 discipline** (STA or DNF or DYN/DYNB)
- **99,- EUR - 2 disciplines** (STA+DNF or STA+DYN/DYNB or DNF+DYN/DYNB)
- **119,- EUR - 3 disciplines** (STA+DNF+DYN/DYNB)
- **+ 20,- EUR Late registration from 20 October**

Please note that the entry fee is NONREFUNDABLE!

- 8. The first 40 participants who register in at least 2 disciplines will be entitled to the nOxyCup Welcome Package.**

9. General Terms & Conditions

- a) The competition will follow CMAS protocols.
- b) The event has CMAS world record status.
- c) Athletes must use equipment for warm up and competition in accordance with the competition rules according to CMAS rules.
- d) Athletes take part in the competition at their own risk.

10. Organizational details

- a) The competition for each discipline will be conducted for both sexes at the same time (female and male)
- b) Warm-up time (WT) and Top Time will be defined based on the personal best performance.
- c) Announcement per discipline shall be made at registration.

11. Pools

- a) Static apnea will take place in a 110 cm deep indoor pool with warm water (29 Celsius)
- b) Dynamic Apnea will take place in a 50 m pool (depth: 300 cm, 26-27 Celsius)

12. Ranking

The performances will be ranked in CMAS ranking. Male and female performances and different age categories will be ranked according to CMAS ranking.

13. Disciplines

Female:

- Static Apnea (STA)
- Dynamic Apnea No Fins (DNF)
- Dynamic Apnea (DYN)
- Dynamic apnea with bi-fins (DYNB)

Male:

- Static Apnea (STA)
- Dynamic Apnea No Fins (DNF)
- Dynamic Apnea (DYN)
- Dynamic Apnea with Bi-fins (DYNB)

14. Competition schedule

15. Protest

Protest is possible for up until 30 minutes after the announcements of preliminary results. The fee is 50,-EUR that will be refunded in case of successful protest. The protest will be judged by the jury.

16. Costs

The cost of the competition itself (including the pool rental, fee of judges, safety, medical staff and the prizes) is covered by the organizers. Athletes must cover their own expenses such as travel, food and accommodation. Athletes and coaches may enter the competition area free of charge after successful registration.

17. Equipment

Athletes must use CMAS competition rule compliant equipment and are accountable for the condition of the equipment used in the competition.

18. Other

- a) The organizer reserves the right to any changes and will inform all athletes in due time.
